## Child Care Subsidy help is available

Families with more than one child aged 5 or younger have been eligible for a higher rate of Child Care Subsidy (CCS) to help with costs since March this year.

To get Child Care Subsidy (CCS) you must:

- care for a child 13 or younger who's not attending secondary school, unless an exemption applies
- use an approved child care service
- be responsible for paying the child care fees
- meet residency and immunisation requirements.

If you are having difficulties paying child care fees, have a chat with the LDC/OSHC staff or the CEO.

Your family circumstances may vary from other families.

CCS replaced Child Care Benefit and Child Care Rebate when they stopped on 1 July 2018.

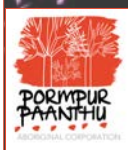
