Pormpuraaw art featured in new airport terminal

Cairns Airport has unveiled a stunning installation of ghostnet artworks by Pormpuraaw Art and Culture Centre artists.

The sculptural works are by Mavis Benjamin, Christine Holroyd, Mylene Holroyd, Alma Norman, Kim Norman, Marlene Norman, and Syd Bruce Shortjoe (pictured above).

They are made from ghostnets and are on permanent display at the new Cairns Domestic Airport Terminal.

The display was the result of a cooperative partnership between the airport and the Cairns Indigenous Art Fair.

It was launched last week with a cultural ceremony featuring a musical performance by featured artist, Syd Bruce Shortjoe.

The artwork resembles a variety of Reef fish including Barramundi, Coronation Coral, Blue Sturgeon, Moorish Idol, Potato Cod and Red Lion; all of which are between one and two metres long and one and two metres high.
