- Listening
- Focusing
- Talking
- Joining in games with family
- Eating, drinking, toileting
- Moving their body on their own

If you are aged under 65 years and have a permanent and significant disability, you may be eligible for NDIS services. If you receive a Disability payment from Centrelink you may be eligible for NDIS.
