## Apply for your director ID online

If you're a director or plan to become a director of an Australian company or Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander corporation, you must apply for a director identification number (director ID).

The fastest way to apply is online at abrs.gov.au/directorID

#### Before you apply



You need a myGovID to apply online

To apply for a director ID online, you need a myGovID with at least a **Standard identity strength**. If you don't have the myGovID app set up on your smart device, visit <a href="https://www.myGovID.gov.au/setup">www.myGovID.gov.au/setup</a>

If you can't download the app or create a myGovID, you will need to apply by phone on **13 62 50**.

#### **Gather your documents**

To apply for your director ID, you need:

- the residential address you have given the ATO
- lacksquare your tax file number (TFN)
- information from 2 documents to verify your identity.

#### How to apply





abrs.gov.au/directorlDapply and select Login.





Enter your myGovID email address.





A **4 digit code** will appear on your browser.





Log in to your **myGovID app** on your smart device and enter or accept the code.





A link to ATO screen will open on your browser.



Use your gathered documents to answer the questions and **Submit**.





The director ID page will **open**.





Select Apply for a director identification number.





Confirm all the **declarations** and **Submit** the information.





Your director ID should now appear **on screen**.
