

## The government has announced an enduring resolution for over 13,000 people affected by the collapse of Youpla/ACBF

- The Youpla Support Program will begin on 1 July 2024 and run for two years.
- It will be open to people who were still making payments to ACBF/Youpla on or after 1 August 2015.
- Those eligible can decide between a government-protected funeral bond or a payment of 60% of premiums paid up to a cap of their Youpla funeral benefit amount. This dignity of choice is a welcome aspect of the enduring resolution. Free financial counselling will be available to support choice.
