About the role:

Joyce Palmer Health Service is a 15-bed primary-level acute facility located on the Aboriginal community of Palm Island.

Casual workers are required for Cleaning/Housekeeping, Kitchenhand, Patient/Staff transport duties at the Joyce Palmer Health Service on Palm Island.

The purpose of the Operational Services Officer role is to work alongside clinical staff to maintain a clean, safe and accessible facility through which health services are delivered to the Palm Island Community.
