Community Members are advised that due to the Tropical Low in the Coral Sea that is likely to become Tropical Cyclone Kirrily in the coming days there will be staff assigned from Council to undertake urgent works around and to help the Community, including:

- Urgent pothole repairs
- Lock down loose items at the lay down yard and dump in preparation for cyclone
- Outreach to community members that live in Camps in outlying areas.

Community Members should do a check around their yards:

- Remove and place any objects in that could be a potential flying hazard.
- · Tape windows to prevent glass breaking
- Check your emergency kit-stock up on water, non-perishable food, batteries, torches, candles, matches etc.
- Families should be prepared to be without power for several days from later this week.
- Families at Camps, should move to a safer place to stay with families.
- Check on your elderly neighbours if they need assistance.
