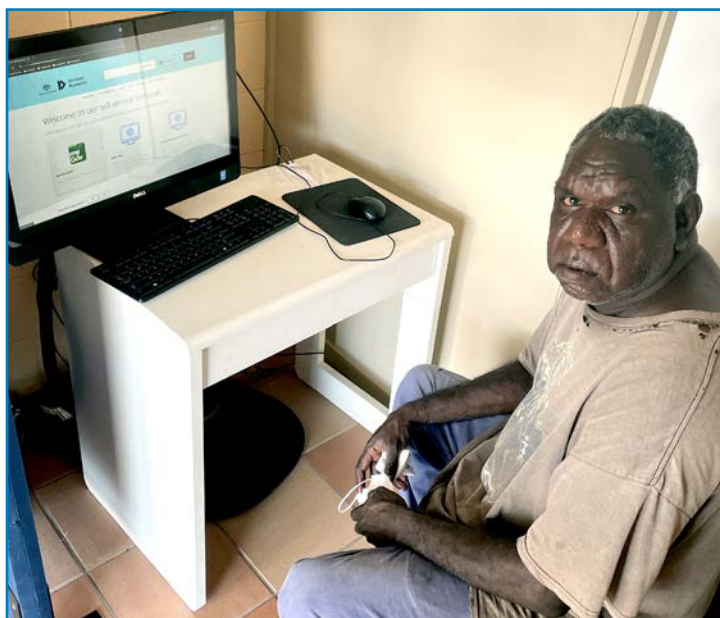
Technology workshop helps with online issues
