I attended Christmas Parties at both our Cairns Office and here in Pormpuraaw.


This year, everyone received a Yeti Bottle with their name engraved on it and a store gift voucher.

In early December, the Air Force Christmas Hop came to Pormpuraaw bearing presents, including toys, sporting equipment and education resources.

The Royal Australian Air Force C-27J Spartan and C-130J Hercules aircraft play a key role in the delivery, which was supported by the Australian Army's 51st Battalion, Far North Queensland Regiment.

The donations were also coordinated in partnership with the Australian Olympic Committee (AOC), who sent two-time Olympic boxing champion Brad Hore and Australian Olympic Committee member Tess Adler along for the ride.

Deputy Prime Minister, Richard Marles said Exercise Christmas Hop was about spreading joy and supporting communities in Far North Queensland during the festive season.

"This initiative reflects the strong connection between our Defence Force and remote communities, and highlights the generosity of Australians who help make Christmas special for every child," he said.

CEO Janelle Menzies said the school and members of the community met with the jet and selected Christmas presents.

"I have also included a photo from ring around the sun which formed whilst the Air Force were visiting," she said.


