

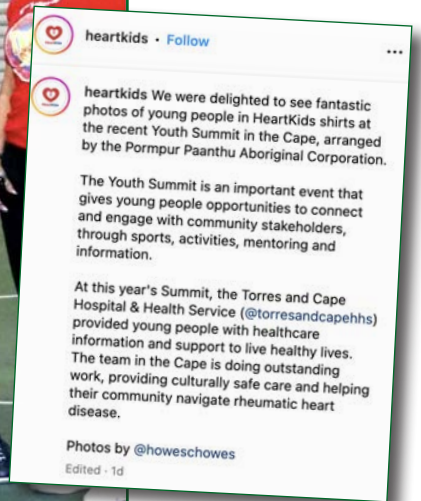

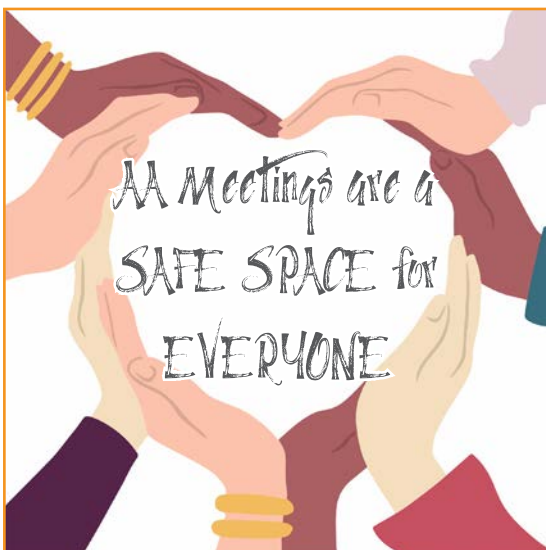

To apply for EVP

1. Check you are eligible
2. Complete an application
3. Have supporting documents ready

EVP is available to all eligible individuals, regardless of gender.

Remember

If you are already working with a support service speak with them about the EVP and they can help you with your eligibility, application and supporting documents.

INTIMATE PARTNER is someone you are or were in a romantic relationship with (eg. husband, wife, partner, boyfriend, girlfriend)

Intimate partner violence can be:

sexual abuse

financial abuse

coercive control

physical abuse

emotional abuse

verbal abuse
