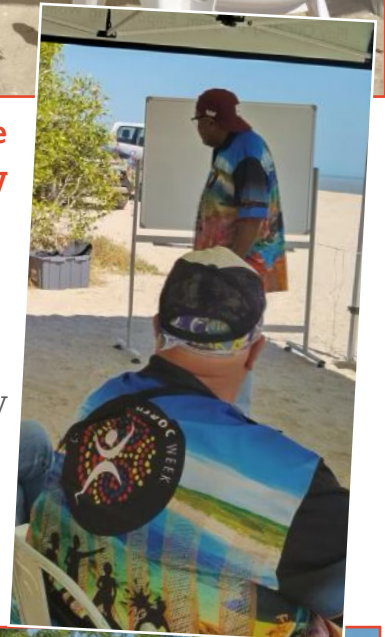
“It was a great opportunity for our organisation—board, management, and staff—to strengthen relationships and build capacity through team-building activities,” she said.
