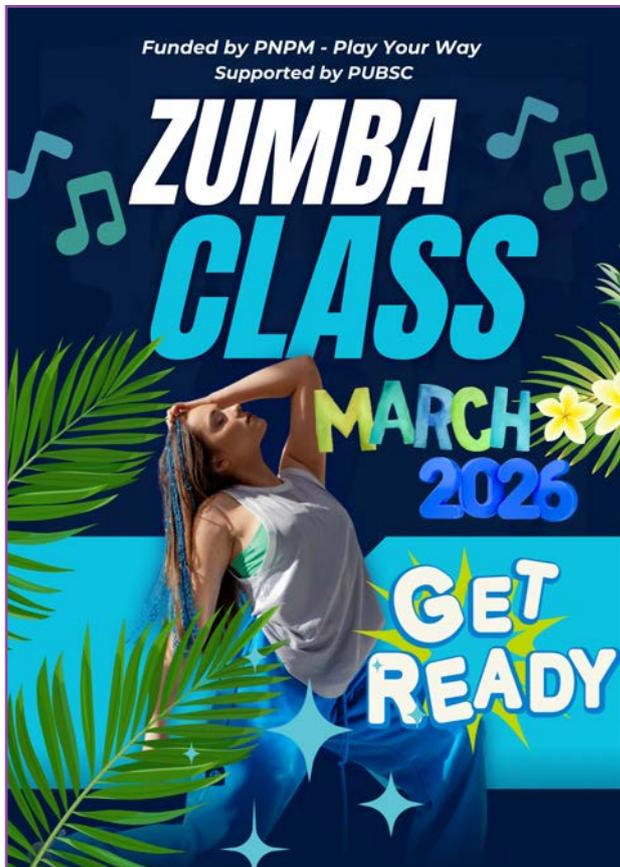
# CYCLONE & STORM-READY LIST
