On Friday 10 June, there were 2,548 new cases of COVID recorded in Queensland.

Of Friday's new cases, 18 cases were Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander people and there were 1,253 active COVID-19 cases in Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander people in Queensland.

In Queensland during the pandemic, 42 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people have died of COVID-19.
