



Vet service a huge step up

The Council's new Palm Island vet service has been warmly embraced by locals, Mayor Mislam Sam says.

He said a full suite of veterinary services were now in place on Palm.

"Surgeries have started, with a large number of desexing operations done in the first full two day clinic over last Friday and Saturday," he said.

"With new equipment, never before available to residents and their animals, and a dedicated team of specialist staff, the Vet service is definitely off and flying.

"A regular service schedule has been established and consultations will continue to be free for the month of February – certainly a very, very welcome investment by Council in supporting local families.

"Surgeries are also provided at below cost price for the immediate future, thanks to Council subsidies, so please make an appointment and get your animals vaccinated, desexed, microchipped and registered as soon as possible."
